
Kingdom Leadership Institute (KLI) - Course Instruction

KLI Mission:

To provide an educational experience that will equip and send visionary servant leaders to oversee initiatives that help carry the Gospel to all nations.



KLI Curriculum:

Inspired by the Hebrew word *avodah*, you will receive instruction opening the door to a journey of worship, work and service. The KLI curriculum has five parts. The Course Instruction is part of an experience referred to as *The Journey*.

The Journey:

This journey will lay a foundation centered in the Kingdom of God challenging you to lead as Jesus would lead if Jesus were you. You will learn to live an authentic leadership lifestyle with a kingdom mindset rooted in who you are and who you are becoming. You will discover how to apply spiritual, authentic Kingdom leadership to your respective context.

Journey Expectations:

- Daily rhythms will be established.
- > Presentations will be personal with a mentoring feel.
- ➤ A leadership learning community will be created.
- > Exploration of ideas rooted in scripture that equip for leadership service with a kingdom mindset.

Journey Destinations:

- > Learn how to cultivate a relationship with King Jesus.
- Discover who you are and who you are becoming.
- Discern the voice of God and what he is calling you to do.
- > Explore practicing love, humility, and honor in community.
- Develop a "Spiritual Leadership Creed" intended to provide continual guidance in your life and leadership including a personal mission statement.
- > Create a stewardship plan discerning how to intentionally invest in God-given relationships and gifts.
- > Create a personal journal articulating your journey in learning to live and lead with an authentic leadership lifestyle.
- > Identify a kingdom leadership mindset and apply it to various spheres of influence.

Journey Experiences:

A leadership learning community will be created. We will gather around a table presenting, discussing, and applying biblical leadership ideas with significant time given to reflection, participation, and relationship building.

These experiences will include, but are not limited to:

- Scriptural and devotional readings.
- Times for reflection.
- Discovering who you are and who you are becoming.
- > Presentations and conversations on cultivating a heart for the king.
- Presentations and conversations about hearing the voice of God.
- > Presentations and conversations on leading with a kingdom mindset.
- Presentations and conversations about living an authentic leadership lifestyle.
- > Exposure to literature informing your thinking about leadership service with a kingdom mindset.

Journey Creations:

- 1. Create a journal about what is happening in your mind and heart.
- 2. Create an "Authentic Spiritual Leader's Creed."
- 3. Create presentations about who you are and who you are becoming.
- 4. Participate in a Solitude and Silence retreat.
- 5. Participate in a Ropes Course experience.
